The International PATHWAYS Conference will present the results and policy recommendation to support employment of people with chronic diseases in Europe

Pathways Project (<http://www.path-ways.eu/>) involves 12 partners from 10 different European countries, and aimed to:

- Identify integration and re-integration strategies that are available in Europe for persons with chronic diseases,
- Determine their effectiveness;
- Assess specific employment related needs of persons with chronic diseases
- Develop Policy guidelines and recommendations supporting the implementation of effective professional integration and reintegration strategies.

The 20th March, at European Parliament in Brussels, will be held the Final International Conference of the project: Employment & Chronic Diseases: New Pathways in Europe. The increasing prevalence of chronic conditions among European working age population, as well as the implications reflected in individual and societal level, underline the need for policy guidelines targeting the effective inclusion of people with chronic conditions in the workplace. Policy Guidelines and Recommendations on innovative strategies for professional integration and reintegration of people with chronic diseases have been developed by Pathways and will be presented.
